While we have set a **deadline of April 26** for receipt of applications, most brackets will fill before this deadline. Thus, you should submit your application and fee as early as possible to insure acceptance. Teams are admitted on a first-come basis. We will notify any teams as soon as possible if they cannot be admitted. **A significant number of teams are always turned away once their brackets are filled. SUBMIT YOUR ENTRY EARLY!**

Schedules will be posted on our web site by Sunday, May 2.

All teams must be registered either through North Texas Soccer or another state soccer association affiliated with U.S. Youth Soccer. Teams from outside North Texas Soccer must submit the appropriate travel papers and bring the appropriate player and coach IDs. You will also need to have medical releases (notarized and to-be-checked for academy and competitive--signed forms with a medical release statement will suffice for recreational) for each player and all coaches should have their North Texas Soccer ID card.
