## **Guest Player Information**

- A “guest player” is a player currently registered on another team (or otherwise registered for the current season with North Texas Soccer), who plans to play with your team for a particular tournament.
- A North Texas Soccer [Guest Player Release form](#) would need to be completed (including all appropriate signatures). Copies of these forms must be submitted to the respective tournament.
- FWYSA tournaments typically allow up to 3 guest players for recreational teams (not to exceed maximum roster size at the tournament) and 5 guest players for competitive teams (not to exceed maximum roster size at the tournament). You should check with each individual tournament as to the maximum numbers for those tournaments.
- Tournaments may have deadlines for receipt of completed guest player forms. Be sure to check with each tournament.
- If the tournament involves travel outside the North Texas Soccer area, check with North Texas Soccer ([www.ntxsoccer.org](http://www.ntxsoccer.org)) about necessary procedures.
- Recreational players may guest play on competitive teams; however, competitive players may not guest play on recreational teams.
- If the player is not currently registered with a North Texas Soccer home association, they must do so. Any player within the FWYSA geographic area may register as a non-rostered recreational player, and the FWYSA Registrar would sign a Guest Player Release form both as “Releasing Coach” and as “Home Association.” The registration would only cover the current soccer season (fall or spring—not both). The fee would be the normal fee for any recreational player for that division in that season.
- The Guest Player decision is exclusively a voluntary arrangement involving the player, parents, releasing coach, and receiving coach. FWYSA cannot assist teams in securing their guest players. The role of FWYSA is purely administrative (verifying registration, affixing registration numbers, signing forms, and collecting forms for our tournaments).
